

ROOM HIRES & TOURS

The Feminist Library is available for hire for meetings, workshops, screenings, filming, away days and launches. We offer two spaces: the Library Hall and the Conference Room. We generally cannot accommodate hires during our opening hours but will consider this on a case-by-case basis.

Library Hall

Our Library Hall is an inspiring backdrop for your event, featuring a collection of feminist posters and archival materials.

Capacity: Up to 40 people (seated, theatre-style)

Amenities: Chairs and tables, access to our kitchen (for serving drinks and snacks), projector, speakers, and microphones

Conference Room

Our Conference Room is ideal for smaller meetings, book groups, and intimate events. It features our fiction collection as a backdrop and includes a whiteboard for collaborative activities. It has a fixed layout of one large, central table surrounded by chairs.

Capacity: Up to 12 people

Booking Information

Location: The Sojourner Truth Community Centre, 161 Sumner Road, London, SE15 6JL

Notice: We require a minimum of **4 weeks' notice** for all bookings. Requests with less than 4 weeks' notice will only be considered under urgent circumstances.

Cleaning: If you are serving food, please clean up any leftovers to protect our collection. Our fees support the maintenance of our physical space, the care of our collections, and ensure a living wage for our staff. Payments must be made in advance — please refer to the cancellation policy below.

Payment and Cancellation Policy

Payment is required in advance for all tours, workshops, and venue hires. Cancellations or rebooking requests must be made at least **24 hours** in advance for tours and workshops, and **72 hours** in advance for venue hires.

Cancellations made within these timeframes, or no-shows without notice, are **non-refundable**.

Solidarity Venue Hire at the Feminist Library

The Feminist Library is a grassroots, unfunded space supporting radical and community-led work. Universities, mainstream charities, and other funded institutions are not eligible for our solidarity rate. This rate is reserved for charities with a significant local presence and other grassroots, community-based initiatives.

Rates *

Hall Half Day – up to 4 hours: £70 / £180

Hall Full Day – 8 hours: £150 / £370

Conference Room Half Day – up to 4 hours: £25 / £135

Conference Room Full Day – 8 hours: £50 / £270

** We generally require two people to be on site for every event and our rates are inclusive of this cost, our staff is paid £13.85/h (London Living Wage) – this is reflected in the higher price, and we ask that you pay this if you are able.*

We mainly accept events with no ticketing fees. If you want to have an entry fee to your event, please specify how much and why. Depending on the event and how we will collaborate on it, the FL might take a percentage of the entry fee.

We strive to keep our space accessible to grassroots and community-led organisations. If you require space for organising, fundraising, or community education and cannot afford the rates, please get in touch.
